



- 3. Apply the primer to the rear bumper:
 - Using your thumb, crush the dot on the primer container, then push the felt until it soaks up the primer.
 - Using both containers, apply primer to the rear bumper. Wipe up any spilled or excess primer.
 - Allow the primer to dry for at least 5 minutes.



4. On the back of the rear bumper trim, attach a strip of masking tape to the end of each outer adhesive backing, and peel back 2 to 3 inches (5 to 8 cm) of the adhesive backing. Fold the ends back, then tape them to the front of the rear bumper trim. Remove and discard all of the inner adhesive backing.



5. Position the rear bumper trim on the rear bumper. While applying light pressure on the rear bumper, carefully remove all the adhesive backing strips from the rear bumper trim.



6. After installing the rear bumper trim, apply pressure to the bumper trim with the palm of your hand for 30 seconds.
