


Driver's side all-season mat



Passenger's side all-season mat




Rear all-season mat





INSTALLATION

NOTE:


- Before installing the all-season mats, identify their installation positions.
- Anchors are required for the driver's side of the vehicle; the anchors prevent the front all-season mat from sliding forward and possibly interfering with the pedals.
- If you remove the front all-season mat, make sure you reanchor it when you put it back in your vehicle.
- If you replace the all-season mat, use factory mats designed to be used with the anchors.
- Do not put the all-season mat on top of the anchored mat. The additional mat may slide forward and possibly interfere with the pedals.
- 1. If equipped, remove the standard floor mats.

- 2. Place the driver's side all-season mat over the anchors as shown.
- 3. Turn the knobs on the two anchors to secure the driver's side all-season mat.

4. Place the passenger's side all-season mat in the passenger's footwell.


